

SUPERNOVA ACRO STUDIO

Warmest welcome to all of my new students and welcome back for those returning to Supernova Acro! I am excited for our new season to begin even though it may be a bit different, I promise we are still going to have great classes!!

All of our classes are technique and exam based classes....our Acrobatic Arts Exams will be held in February 2021. If your daughter/son is interested in being on one of our competitive acro teams you can register for those on the Dakiki site. You can also request solo or duets (please note to qualify for competitive you must be taking dance at a competitive studio or through Supernova). We attend 4 local dance competitions and one travel for the Elite team. Costume cost is roughly \$75-\$150 and competition fees are about \$165. Please email me for any competitive requests!

Acro Classes

Attire: Black bodysuit or half top and black shorts or leggings (colours are fine but NO BAGGY CLOTHES) Hair must be in bun or braids.

What to bring:

1. Yoga blocks (2) **I have some to sell....email me to purchase! \$5/block**
2. Acro Mat or thick yoga mat (optional) but if you have your own pls bring!!
Email to confirm you have a mat!
3. Skipping rope (acro level 4+)
4. Hand sanitizer
5. Water bottle

I encourage you to have an acro back pack you can carry your things in to bring to and from classes!

Jazz/Flex Classes

Attire: Same as acro

Shoes: Beige jazz shoes (can purchase at On Stage, All4dance)

What to bring:

1. Yoga blocks (2)
2. Thick Yoga mat (optional)
3. Water bottle
4. Hand sanitizer

Choreo Classes

Attire: Same as acro

What To bring:

1. Water Bottle
2. Hand sanitizer

Fees:
